We proudly partnered with the Menstruation Foundation to address period poverty through the installation of a sanitary pad vending machine at Velddrif High School.



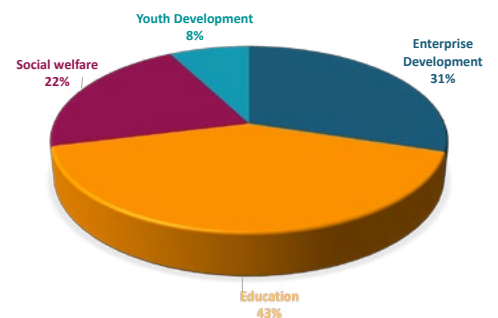
This project provides free access to sanitary pads for up to 200 school girls per month, as well as educating young ladies about menstruation and women's health.
