SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT GRADUATES

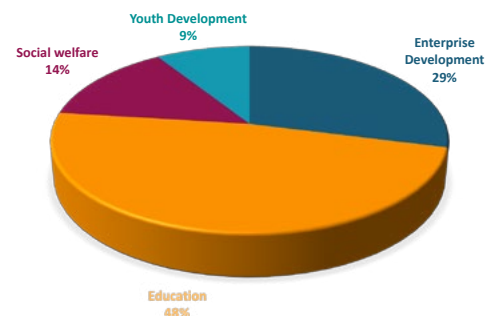
